Non-accessible Content

The following content is not accessible for the following reasons—non-compliance with Law No. 4 of January 9, 2004:

• Requirement 9.4.1.2 – In some cases, user interface components (including form elements, links, and script-generated components...) do not have the correct or properly set name, role, states, properties, and values, or users and their assistive technologies are not notified when these change.

• Requirement 9.4.1.3 – In some cases, status messages are not presented to the user in a way that allows assistive technologies to interpret them without moving the focus.
